Residency at CAB for a Swiss artist in connection with the South America programme [«COINCIDENCIA»](#) of the Swiss Arts Council Pro Helvetia.

The aim is to bring together art, science and the humanities to foster this interdisciplinary dialogue in terms of both research and practice.

WHO IS THIS RESIDENCY FOR?

We invite swiss artists, architects or researchers interested in transdisciplinary artistic, scientific and humanistic dialogue working in the fields of contemporary art. Participants can develop a research, an ephemeral site-specific work or any proposal that they consider to embrace, experiment with or introduce into the concept of study.

Applicants must have an interest in investigation processes, South America's southern territory and its history, and should be comfortable interacting with an exploration team, including Chilean artists and researchers from other disciplines. It is therefore preferable to have a working knowledge of the Spanish language. The residency will be in an isolated and rural environment, so good physical condition is needed.

RESIDENCY CONDITIONS

Duration: two weeks. In case of Covid 19 cancelation we will perform a virtual version of the residency program.

Working language: Spanish

Number of residents during the program: 3 artists (there is only one vacancy for swiss artist) and 2-3 academics or researchers.

Disciplines and media: Science Art, Visual Art, New Media, Cross Art Form, Sound Art, Architecture.

EXPENSES COVERED BY THE RESIDENCY PROGRAM

- Travel expenses (economy round trip ticket Switzerland-Chile);
- Accommodation in Santiago-Punta Arenas- Tierra del Fuego;
- Per diem;
- Opportunity to show your artwork production at the Bienal de Artes Mediales de Chile (without production costs. October 2021).

Residents will get the opportunity to share and gather with a group of scientists, academics, artists and locals to get involved in the territory, its history and particularities.

AS RESIDENT, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO

- Deliver a public talk about your research and artistic practice for a student audience in Santiago (to be confirmed);
- Cite the names of your scientific collaborators when the produced artwork participates in exhibitions or is being published / reproduced (e.g. "created at CAB Residency, sponsored by COINCIDENCIA program of the Swiss Art Council Pro Helvetia");
- Collaborate with CAB researchers and scientists around the concept "Conscience" and participate in all activities proposed in the schedule of the residency;
- Provide images, photos, videos or any material relevant for diffusion and press requirements (social media, institutional CAB website and other noncommercial purpose)
